Round	London Championship: WA18 Round. Archery Fit (AF) Championship: WA18 Round followed by WA Indoor Match Round. Any Archery GB / WA affiliated archer can enter the Championship, but only London Archery Association affiliated archers will qualify for London Championship rankings.

Date	Saturday 17 th October 2020 (Olympic recurve & Barebow) & Sunday 18 th October 2020, (Compound & Longbow), start at 8:00, full schedule below.	
Venue	Archery Fit, Hatfield House, Merryweather Place, London, SE10 8EW (www.archeryfit.com/when-where.html). Club gate is next to the Premier Inn Hotel on Greenwich High Road. Please dial 888-call on the gate buzzer to get in. The entrance is across the yard to the right from the gate. The venue is wheelchair accessible. Restrooms are available at all times.	
Event Format	1. Olympic recurve archers (men & women) and Barebow archers (men & women) will shoot on Saturday 17 th October 2020, Compound archers (men & women) & Longbow archers (men & women) on Sunday 18 th October 2020. 2. Categories: 2.1. London Championship: senior, any adult 18+ & junior, any junior 8-17. 2.2. AF Championship: senior, any adult 18+. Juniors 8-17 shoot in one group with senior archers. 3. All Olympic recurve and Compound archers will shoot on a vertical 3-spot 40cm face. All Barebow and Longbow archers will shoot on a 40cm full face. 4.1. London Championship results will be based on WA18 Round (WA Indoor Match Round results relevant to AF Championship only). 4.2. AF Championship: after WA18 Round the top 16 archers of each gender in each discipline will progress to WA Indoor Match Round.	
Notes	1. Archery GB / World Archery affiliated club valid membership card required. 2. Men & women shoot in separate groups (unless women willingly enter men's group). 3. Archers & Para-archers shoot in one group. 4. Archers can only enter one WA18 Round session of a day, shooting both sessions is not allowed. 5. Target butts: modular foam targets. 6. Bows up to 60lb, no higher poundage allowed. 7. No refunds offered.
